Safety Advice for parents and children on the reopening of playgrounds

A PLAY AREA IS A HIGH RISK AREA FOR TRANSMISSION OF COVID19

We are aiming to reduce social interaction between people to minimise the opportunity for transmission of Covid19

- **Please do not use the play area if you or any members of your household are displaying Covid19 symptoms**
- **Please behave responsibly**
- **Consumption of food & drink is banned**
- **Please provide your own hand sanitiser/wipes to clean hands particularly at the beginning and end of play**
- **Remind your children not to touch their face or put fingers in their mouths, and to cough or sneeze into a tissue or arm when a tissue is not available**

- **If possible, wear a face covering in an area where you may come into contact with people you do not normally meet (face coverings should not be used by children under the age of 3 or those who may find it difficult to manage them correctly)**
- **If the play area is busy, consider coming back at a later time, talk to your children about this possibility before visiting**
- **In busy periods, 20 minutes max play, please be considerate to others waiting**
- **Help to build awareness of the need for regular handwashing (before and after visiting)**

- Always adhere to the social distancing guidelines, keeping 2m apart is still recommended, if not possible, a distance of at least 1m should be maintained with additional precautions (such as a face mask or keeping any interaction brief)
- **Please use the bins provided**
- Children must be accompanied by an adult from their household (please limit to 1 adult accompanying children)
