Information was shared about the planning application from Magnox

1.	Apologies and Absence Councillor Ashton gave her apologies
2.	Declarations of Interest Councillor Pinnell declared a personal interest in the application 16/0019/STMAJW. Councillor Pinnell remained in the meeting but took no part in the vote. Councillor Tucker declared a personal interest in the application S.16/0595/HHOLD. Councillor Tucker remained in the meeting but took no part in the vote.
3.	Planning Applications It was agreed by all those present and voting to make the following responses 16/0019/STMAJW - Berkeley Town Council acknowledges the economic and safety case for the location of waste from Oldbury Power Station to the Intermediate Level Waste Store at the Berkeley site. However, the Council would point out that whilst there is considerable public interest in this proposal, there has been poor public communication. The present proposal is that the taxpayer receives all of the benefit, at least £20million, from the proposed change in the planning condition, however, the Council considers that the community should receive some of the saving, in the order of 10%, to offset the adverse public perception and the impact of the additional heavy traffic on the roads, which are already in poor condition.
