Deputy Chairman George Fryer took the Chair

Councillor Mike Studden submitted a written report titled "Berkeley Town Council Annual Report 2014/15" which was distributed to those present

Tom Beasley presented an overview of the New Green College proposed for the old laboratories site next to Berkeley Power Station which was followed by a Q & A session.

Councillor George Fryer gave a presentation on the reasons for considering a 20m.p.h. speed limit in Berkeley which was followed by a discussion on the subject

Councillor Liz Ashton gave a presentation on the reasons for increasing CCTV coverage in the town centre which was followed by a discussion on the subject

Stroud District Councillor Gordon Craig read out a report that he had written which he followed with a Q & A session

**PUBLIC DISCUSSION**

There followed a period when various members of the public raised issues that concerned them which was followed by discussions on each subject
