



6.	<p>Budget Proposal 2019/20</p> <p>It was agreed to increase the Youth Club budget to £ 9,500.00</p> <p>It was agreed to add £ 1,000.00 to the Allotments budget</p>
7.	<p>Stroud District Council Community Governance Review</p> <p>It was agreed that Berkeley Town Council will make no response to the Community Governance Review except to say that we should leave it up to individuals to respond as they see fit.</p>
8.	<p>Tourism &amp; Economic Development Committee</p> <p>It was agreed that Councillors Hall, Somerset and Tucker will take the proposal forward and come back to Council with Terms of Reference at the December meeting</p>
9.	<p>Community Design Statement Steering Group</p> <p>It was agreed that Councillors Tucker and Sealey will work on recruiting residents to the Steering Group by placing an advert in the Flyer</p>
10.	<p>Berkeley Cemetery - access</p> <p>A member of the public has asked if access can be allowed through the gate off of Howmead because some people have difficulty walking from the main entrance to the new burial ground. This applies to people attending funerals and subsequently looking after their loved one's graves.</p> <p>It was agreed that the Council will write to the Berkeley Burial Committee asking it to place signs at the entrances to the Cemetery giving instructions as to how they can access the locked gate off of Howmead</p>

12.	<p>Remembrance 2018</p> <p>Tommy Sculpture</p> <p>It was agreed to purchase a Tommy Sculpture for Berkeley at a cost of £ 776.30 inclusive of delivery and vat</p> <p>It was agreed to create a budget for the purchase and installation of the Tommy Sculpture in the amount of £1000.00</p> <p>Remembrance Sunday Wreath</p> <p>The Royal British Legion always provide us with a wreath that the Council can lay at the Remembrance Sunday Service</p> <p>It was agreed to donate £ 150.00 to the Royal British Legion Poppy Appeal</p>
